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**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Original House Bill No. 1018 by Representative Edmonds

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1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 2, insert "of Subtitle I"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 9, after "Chapter 1" and before "of Title" insert "of Subtitle I"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, at the end of line 19, delete "Monies in the" and delete line 20 in its entirety and  
7 on page 2 delete lines 1 through 4 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

8 "C.(1) Unless specified for deposit into a specific subfund, monies deposited  
9 into the fund shall be allocated to the following subfunds as follows:

10 (a) An amount equal to twenty-four and one-half of one percent of monies  
11 deposited into the fund each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of one hundred  
12 million dollars each year, shall be credited to the Lake Charles Bridge Subfund,  
13 hereby established in the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the  
14 Department of Transportation and Development solely for direct costs associated  
15 with actual project delivery, construction, and maintenance of the I-10 bridge in the  
16 greater Lake Charles area.

17 (b) An amount equal to forty and eight-tenths of one percent of monies  
18 deposited into the fund each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of one hundred  
19 sixty-six million six hundred sixty-six thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars each  
20 year, shall be credited to the Baton Rouge Bridge Subfund, hereby established in the  
21 fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the Department of  
22 Transportation and Development solely for direct costs associated with actual project  
23 delivery, construction, and maintenance of a new bridge in the greater Baton Rouge  
24 area.

25 (c) An amount equal to sixteen and three-tenths of one percent of monies  
26 deposited each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of sixty-six million six hundred  
27 sixty-six thousand six hundred sixty-seven dollars each year, shall be credited to the  
28 Rural Roads and Bridges Subfund, hereby established in the fund. Monies in this  
29 subfund shall be appropriated to the Department of Transportation and Development  
30 solely for direct costs associated with actual project delivery, construction, and  
31 maintenance of rural roads and bridges.

32 (d) An amount equal to six and one-tenth of one percent of monies deposited  
33 into the fund each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of twenty-five million  
34 dollars each year, shall be credited to the Childhood Initiatives Subfund, hereby  
35 established in the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the  
36 Department of Education for early childhood initiatives.

37 (e) An amount equal to six and one-tenth of one percent of monies deposited  
38 into the fund each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of twenty-five million  
39 dollars each year, shall be credited to the Developmental Disability Subfund, hereby  
40 established in the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the  
41 Louisiana Department of Health for community initiatives for the provision of  
42 services to persons with developmental disabilities.

43 (f) An amount equal to six and one-tenth of one percent of monies deposited  
44 into the fund each year, not to exceed an aggregate total of twenty-five million  
45 dollars each year, shall be credited to the Community and Technical Colleges  
46 Subfund, hereby established in the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be

1 appropriated to the board of supervisors for community and technical colleges for  
2 costs associated with enhancing the availability of college courses for non-traditional  
3 students.

4 (2) Monies in each subfund established pursuant to Paragraphs (1) and (4)  
5 of this Section shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general  
6 fund and interest earned on such investment shall be deposited into each subfund.  
7 Unexpended and unencumbered monies in each subfund at the end of each fiscal  
8 year shall remain in the subfund to which they have been credited.

9 (3) Maximum subfund amounts established in Paragraph (1) of this  
10 Subsection shall apply only to the avails of the tax imposed pursuant to R.S.  
11 47:321.1 and shall not apply to monies specifically identified for deposit into such  
12 subfund through donation, appropriation, or funds transfer.

13 (4) If a subfund established pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph (1) of  
14 this Subsection reaches the annual maximum credit amount provided in Paragraph  
15 (1) of this Subsection, not including funds deposited pursuant to Paragraph (2) of this  
16 Subsection, then any additional funds that would have been credited to such subfund  
17 shall be deposited into the Debt Defeasance Subfund, hereby established in the fund.  
18 Monies in this subfund shall be used solely to pay debts owed by the state."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 4

20 On page 2, delete lines 14 through 18 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof:

21 "Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2022; if vetoed by the  
22 governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on  
23 July 1, 2022, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later."
