 Provides relative to the Louisiana Board for Hearing Aid Dealers. (8/1/22)

Proposed law retains present law registration and licensing requirements for the selling and fitting of hearing aids in Louisiana. Proposed law modifies language pertaining to the La Board for Hearing Aid Dealers to reduce redundancies present in existing law and increase clarity of legislative intent surrounding the regulation of hearing aids.
