5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 48:1107 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1107. Greater New Orleans Expressway Commissions; Causeway Police
8	Department
9	The Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission's Causeway Police
10	Department, along with its officers, shall not be required to police the Huey P. Long
11	Bridge.

Abstract: Removes the Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission Causeway Police Department, along with its officers, from assignment on the Huey P. Long Bridge.

<u>Present law</u> requires a portion of the revenues of the Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission remaining at the end of each fiscal year be used for its officers to police the Huey P. Long Bridge. <u>Proposed law</u> modifies <u>present law</u> by removing the requirement for the Causeway Police Department, along with its officers, to police the Huey P. Long Bridge.
