Abstract: Provides that state buildings are exempt from limitations associated with a disaster or emergency declared by a local official.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes parish presidents to declare states of emergency or disaster and provides for his authority during such a declaration. Provide similarly regarding the authority of the mayor of a municipality.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that during a state of emergency or disaster declared by a local official, state buildings and facilities are not subject to any rule, procedure, guidance, restriction, prohibition, or limitation that stems from the declaration.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
