14	(b)(i) Upon second conviction, be fined seven hundred dollars and sentenced
15	to serve sixteen hours of community service in a litter abatement work program as
16	approved by the court.
17	(ii) In addition to penalties otherwise provided in this Paragraph, a person
18	convicted or held liable for a second or subsequent offense of littering from a vehicle
19	under this Subsection may, upon motion of the prosecuting district attorney, have his
20	vehicle seized and impounded, and held until such time as the offender has paid the
21	fine as required by this Paragraph when the offender is the registered owner of the
22	vehicle being operated at the time of the offense.
