

**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

2022 Regular Session

Substitute for Original House Bill No. 1050 by Representative Glover as proposed by the House Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs

To enact R.S. 48:954, relative to state bridges; to prohibit certain parish and municipal governments from accepting ownership or responsibility for such a bridge; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 48:954 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§954. State bridges; prohibitions

No municipality that meets the following criteria nor the parish in which such a municipality is located shall accept any ownership interest in or financial responsibility or legal liability for a bridge that on July 1, 2022, is part of the state highway system:

(1) The population of the municipality is greater than one hundred thousand persons according to the most recent federal census.

(2) The governing authority of the municipality is not consolidated with the governing authority of the parish in which it is located.
