# HEALTH: Creates and provides for the Health Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION			
2	To create the Health Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force as a subcommittee of the			
3	Statewide Health Equity Consortium within the Louisiana Department of Health, to			
4	provide for the composition and duties of the task force, and to require the task force			
5	to report findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on health and			
6	welfare.			
7	WHEREAS, according to the United States Centers for Disease Control and			
8	Prevention, overall health outcomes for African Americans, Hispanic Americans, and			
9	American Indians in this country are far poorer than for white people; and			
10	WHEREAS, vast health disparities persist in this country, particularly in rural areas,			
11	and many have worsened during the COVID-19 pandemic; and			
12	WHEREAS, rural areas comprise roughly eighty percent of Louisiana's total			
13	geographic area; and			
14	WHEREAS, nearly twenty-six percent of our state's population, totaling more than			
15	one million two hundred thousand Louisianans, live in rural communities; and			
16	WHEREAS, sixty-three of Louisiana's sixty-four parishes are classified as health			
17	professional shortage areas according to the standards of the federal Health Resources and			
18	Services Administration; and			
19	WHEREAS, approximately ninety-eight percent of this state's entire population lives			
20	in a federally designated health professional shortage area; and			

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1	WHEREAS, the vast majority of Louisiana's rural communities are medically			
2	underserved by all established measures, yet programs to address the healthcare needs of this			
3	population remain underfunded and few are guided by local stakeholders or locally			
4	conducted needs assessments; and			
5	WHEREAS, in consideration of the findings set forth in this Resolution, the			
6	legislature hereby declares that improving health outcomes in rural communities is a critical			
7	public health priority of this state.			
8	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby			
9	create the Health Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force.			
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall be composed of the			
11	following members:			
12	(1) The president of the board of directors of the Louisiana State Nurses Association			
13	or his designee.			
14	(2) One member who possesses postgraduate degrees in both nursing and business			
15	administration appointed by the director of clinical practice, health policy, and advocacy of			
16	the Louisiana State Nurses Association.			
17	(3) The executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Nursing or his designee.			
18	(4) The executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners or his			
19	designee.			
20	(5) The dean of the Southern University School of Nursing or his designee.			
21	(6) The president of the board of directors of the Louisiana Association of Nurse			
22	Practitioners or his designee.			
23	(7) The chief executive officer of the Louisiana State Medical Society or his			
24	designee.			
25	(8) The chief operating officer of the Rural Hospital Coalition, Inc. or his designee.			
26	(9) The president of the Louisiana Hospital Association or his designee.			
27	(10) The executive director of the Louisiana Rural Health Association or his			
28	designee.			
29	(11) The executive director of the Louisiana Primary Care Association or his			
30	designee.			

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1	(12) The secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health or his designee.			
2	(13) The president of the board of directors of the Louisiana Managed Medicaid			
3	Association or his designee.			
4	(14) The state director of AARP Louisiana or his designee.			
5	(15) A certified nurse midwife appointed by the executive director of the Louisiana			
6	State Board of Nursing.			
7	(16) The president of the board of directors of the Louisiana Academy of Family			
8	Physicians or his designee.			
9	(17) One primary care physician from each of the six Louisiana congressional			
10	districts appointed by the president of the board of directors of the Louisiana Academy of			
11	Family Physicians.			
12	(18) The president of the Louisiana Council of Administrators in Nursing Education			
13	or his designee.			
14	(19) The president of the Black Nurses Association of Acadiana or his designee.			
15	(20) The president of the Louisiana Independent Pharmacies Association.			
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duties of the task force shall include, without			
17	limitation, all of the following:			
18	(1) Identifying the key drivers of health disparities in rural areas.			
19	(2) Considering social determinants of health in developing recommendations for			
20	delivering high-quality health care in rural areas.			
21	(3) Studying practicable solutions for reducing healthcare provider shortages in rural			
22	communities of Louisiana.			
23	(4) Collaborating with health professional licensing boards of this state to draft			
24	proposals for legislation that will foster greater access to care for rural residents.			
25	(5) Developing proposals for healthcare workforce training initiatives which			
26	promote diversity in health professions.			
27	(6) Studying the impact of access to broadband internet and other technologies that			
28	facilitate wider deployment of telehealth and telemedicine services and thereby improve			
29	access to care in rural areas.			

1	(7) Serving as a resource for parish governments to build partnerships for			
2	community outreach to address social determinants of health in rural communities.			
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall be a subcommittee of the			
4	Statewide Health Equity Consortium within the Louisiana Department of Health.			
5	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Statewide Health Equity Consortium shall			
6	convene the first meeting of the task force no later than August 15, 2022.			
7	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, at its first meeting, the task force shall select			
8	from among its members a chairperson and any other officers it deems necessary for the			
9	functioning of the group.			
10	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force may adopt rules of procedure and			
11	any other policies as may be necessary to facilitate the work of the group.			
12	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that on or before March 1, 2023, the task force shall			
13	submit to the House Committee on Health and Welfare, the Senate Committee on Health and			
14	Welfare, and the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library a report of its findings and			
15	recommendations.			
16	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislative authority for the task force shall			
17	terminate on July 1, 2023.			
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the			
19	president of the board of directors and the director of clinical practice, health policy, and			
20	advocacy of the Louisiana State Nurses Association, the executive director of the Louisiana			
21	State Board of Nursing, the executive director of the Louisiana State Board of Medical			
22

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Creates the 25-member Health Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force as a subcommittee of the Statewide Health Equity Consortium within the La. Department of Health and provides for the duties of the task force.

Requires the task force to report its findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on health and welfare on or before March 1, 2023.

#### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the <u>original</u> bill:

- 1. Change the name of the task force from the "Health Inequities and Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force" to the "Health Disparities in Rural Areas Task Force".
- 2. Change the qualifications of one task force member to be appointed by the La. State Nurses Association.
- 3. Change the representative of the La. Managed Medicaid Association on the task force <u>from</u> the association's executive director or his designee <u>to</u> the president of the association's board or his designee.
- 4. Add the following persons as members of the task force:
  - a. One primary care physician from each of the six La. congressional districts appointed by the president of the board of directors of the La. Academy of Family Physicians.
  - b. The president of the La. Council of Administrators in Nursing Education or his designee.
  - c. The president of the Black Nurses Association of Acadiana or his designee.
  - d. The president of the La. Independent Pharmacies Association.
- 5. Require the Statewide Health Equity Consortium, rather than the secretary of the La. Department of Health, to convene the first meeting of the task force.
