Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 795 by Representative Pressly

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1**2** On page 2, delete lines 25 through 27 in their entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

3 "E. Subject to appropriation and the provisions of this Section, monies in the
4 fund shall be used by the Department of Economic Development, hereinafter referred
5 to in this Section as the "department", for awarding grants to selected applicants.
6 The department shall"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2**8** On page 3, at the beginning of line 3, delete "F." and insert in lieu thereof "F.(1)"**9** AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 3, between lines 7 and 8, insert "(2) In fiscal year 2025-2026, in addition to any
11 monies disbursed from the fund pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, an amount of
12 up to one hundred and five thousand dollars of fund monies shall be allocated to the
13 department for administrative costs."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 3, line 8, after "G." and before "all of the following" delete "Only applicants that
16 meet" and insert in lieu thereof "An applicant that meets"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5**18** On page 3, at the beginning of line 9, delete "the grants" and insert in lieu thereof "a grant"**19** AMENDMENT NO. 6**20** On page 3, after line 20, insert the following:

21 "Section 2. The provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become effective when an
22 Act of the Louisiana Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the
23 implementation of the provisions of this Act becomes effective.

24 Section 3. The provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective
25 upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time
26 for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section
27 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved
28 by the legislature, the provisions of Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on
29 the day following such approval."
