Present law provides for a list of legal holidays and days of public rest.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and removes Robert E. Lee Day, Confederate Memorial Day, President George Washington's birthday, and Huey P. Long Day as legal holidays. Adds President's Day as a legal holiday.
