Abstract: Provides relative to the addition and removal of certain holidays as legal holidays.

Present law provides for a list of legal holidays and days of public rest.

Proposed law retains present law and removes Robert E. Lee Day, Confederate Memorial Day, President George Washington's birthday, and Huey P. Long Day as legal holidays. Adds President's Day as a legal holiday.

(Amends R.S. 1:55(A)(1) and (7), (B)(2), (D), and (E)(1)(a)(i))

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes.
2. Add and remove certain holidays from present law (R.S. 1:55(A)(7), (B)(2), (D), and (E)).
