Engrossed House Bill No. 325 by Representative Stefanski

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, after "To" and before "repeal" insert "enact R.S. 40:600.112 and to"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 24 On page 1, line 3, after "Commission" and before "to" insert "and the Louisiana Housing
5 Corporation"6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, between lines 4 and 5, insert:

8 "Section 1. R.S. 40:600.112 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

9 §600.112. Louisiana Housing Corporation; teleconference meetings10 A. Subject to the limitations set forth in Title 42 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes
11 of 1950, the Louisiana Housing Corporation may hold periodic meetings via electronic
12 means as defined in R.S. 42:17.1 as part of a regular schedule if such meetings comply with
13 all of the following:14 (1) A physical anchor location for the meeting shall be established from which the
15 meeting shall originate and at which the presiding officer of the meeting shall be present and
16 conduct the meeting. Any member of the Louisiana Housing Corporation or any member of
17 the public may participate in person at the anchor location.18 (2) Such meetings shall comply with the requirements of R.S. 42:14, 16, 17, 19, 20,
19 and 23.20 (3) The Louisiana Housing Corporation shall adopt and publish procedures for notice
21 of and the conduct of such meeting in advance thereof including but not limited to the means
22 for participation and providing testimony or public comment prior to and during the meeting,
23 including a toll-free call in line for participants and the public, the number for which shall
24 be posted on the website of the Louisiana Housing Corporation.25 (4) All public comments received in writing or by email shall be read into the record
26 during the meeting.27 (5) All votes taken in the meeting shall be by roll call vote.28 (6) The entire meeting with the exception of a duly called executive session shall be
29 audible to the public and broadcast over the internet.30 (7) The meeting shall be recorded and made available to the public in an online
31 archive located on the website of the Louisiana Housing Corporation.32 (8) If a problem occurs that causes the meeting to no longer be visible or audible to
33 the public, the meeting shall be recessed until the problem is resolved. If the problem is not
34 resolved in two hours or less, the meeting shall be adjourned.35 B.(1) The number of meetings held via electronic means authorized by this Section
36 shall be one teleconference meeting per quarter during a calendar year.37 (2) Under no circumstances shall the Louisiana Housing Corporation conduct
38 successive meetings by teleconference.39 C. A meeting held pursuant to this Section shall not require a quorum to be present
40 at the anchor location of the meeting. All members of the Louisiana Housing Corporation
41 participating at the anchor location or electronically shall be counted for purposes of
42 establishing a quorum.43 D. The provisions of this Section shall not limit the conduct of meetings via
44 electronic means during a gubernatorially proclaimed or declared disaster or emergency in
45 the manner provided by R.S. 42:17.1.46 E. The Louisiana Housing Corporation may adopt rules, regulations, and procedures
47 to allow the public to participate in a meeting via electronic means.

1 F. For purposes of this Section, "anchor location" means the physical location from
2 which the meeting via electronic means originates or the participants are connected."
