**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. The Office of Group Benefits (OGB) will engage its contracted actuarial services vendor to assist it in studying the costs and benefits for fire protection officers to participate in OGB Life, Health, or other insurance programs, and to assist it in the preparation of the required report. These activities are within the scope of the existing actuarial services contract between OGB and the vendor; accordingly no additional expenditures are anticipated to be incurred. The Department of Insurance reports that proposed resolution will have no fiscal impact to provide input, recommendations, and advice to the division of administration.

Proposed resolution provides that the division of administration may engage and solicit input, recommendations, and advice from the Department of Insurance, the Professional Fire Fighters Association of Louisiana, and the Group Benefits Policy and Planning Board within the OGB.
