Abstract: Prohibits the use of DNA obtained from a sexual assault collection kit in an investigation against the person who submitted the DNA if that person is charged with or suspected of committing any criminal offense.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that DNA obtained by a criminal justice agency from a sexual assault collection kit shall not be compared with other DNA records for the purpose of investigating the victim of the sexually-oriented criminal offense who submitted the DNA if that victim is charged with or suspected of committing any criminal offense.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> <u>Justice to the original bill:</u>

1. Prohibit the use of DNA obtained by a criminal justice agency from the victim of a sexually-oriented criminal offense from being used for the purpose of investigating the victim of the sexually-oriented criminal offense if that victim is charged with or suspected of committing any criminal offense.
