
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 1018 by Representative Edmonds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, at the end of line 10, insert the following:

3 "However, if the I-10 bridge in the greater Lake Charles area project receives
4 funding from another source and the full annual maximum credit amount is no longer
5 needed to fully fund the project, monies deposited pursuant to the provisions of this
6 Subparagraph that are in excess of the monies needed to fully fund the project shall
7 be deposited into the Non-Federal Eligible Highway Program Subfund established
8 pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph (4) of this Subsection."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 2

10 On page 2, at the end of line 17, insert the following:

11 "However, if the new bridge in the greater Baton Rouge area project receives funding
12 from another source and the full annual maximum credit amount is no longer needed
13 to fully fund the project, monies deposited pursuant to the provisions of this
14 Subparagraph that are in excess of the monies needed to fully fund the project shall
15 be deposited into the Non-Federal Eligible Highway Program Subfund established
16 pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph (4) of this Subsection."

17 AMENDMENT NO. 3

18 On page 2, at the end of line 23, insert the following:

19 "However, if the I-49 south corridor project receives funding from another source
20 and the full annual maximum credit amount is no longer needed to fully fund the
21 project, monies deposited pursuant to the provisions of this Subparagraph that are in
22 excess of the monies needed to fully fund the project shall be deposited into the Non-
23 Federal Eligible Highway Program Subfund established pursuant to the provisions
24 of Paragraph (4) of this Subsection."

25 AMENDMENT NO. 4

26 On page 3, at the end of line 13, insert the following:

27 "The Department of Transportation and Development shall divide the monies
28 received pursuant to the provisions of this Paragraph equally among its nine highway
29 districts."
