
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 1018 by Representative Edmonds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, delete lines 5 through 23 in their entirety and insert the following:

3 "(a) An amount equal to fifty percent of monies deposited into the fund each
4 year shall be credited to the Mega Projects Subfund, hereby established in the fund.
5 Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the Department of Transportation and
6 Development solely for direct costs associated with actual project delivery,
7 construction, and maintenance of the I-10 bridge in the greater Lake Charles area and
8 a new bridge in the greater Baton Rouge area and direct costs associated with the
9 expansion of the I-49 south corridor.

10 (b) An amount equal to forty percent of monies deposited into the fund each
11 year shall be credited to the Non-Federal Eligible Highway Program Subfund, hereby
12 established in the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the
13 Department of Transportation and Development solely for direct costs associated
14 with actual project delivery, construction, and maintenance of highways in the Non-
15 Federal Eligible Highway Program.

16 (c) An amount equal to ten percent of monies deposited into the fund each
17 year shall be credited to the Road Transfer Program Subfund, hereby established in
18 the fund. Monies in this subfund shall be appropriated to the Department of
19 Transportation and Development solely for direct costs associated with projects
20 authorized pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 48:224.1."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 2

22 On page 2, line 24, after "pursuant to" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and at
23 the beginning of line 25, delete "of this Section" and insert "Paragraph (1) of this
24 Subsection"

25 AMENDMENT NO. 3

26 On page 3, delete lines 1 through 13 in their entirety
