1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line
3 3, delete "Opportunity Program for Students;" and insert "R.S. 17:3047.2(A)(1), relative to
4 the M.J. Foster Promise Program;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 3, after "minimum" and before "required" delete "ACT score" and insert
7 "age"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 4, after "for a" and before "and to" delete "TOPS-Tech Award;" and insert
10 "program award;"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 7
13 through 19 and delete page 2 and insert the following:

14 "R.S. 17:3047.2(A)(1) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
15 §3047.2. Initial eligibility
16 A. To be eligible for the award, an applicant shall meet the following
17 requirements:
18 (1) Be at least ~~twenty-one~~ eighteen years old.

20 Section 2. The provisions of R.S. 17:3047.2(A)(1) as amended by this Act
21 shall be implemented beginning with the 2023-2024 academic year."
