
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

2022 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Insurance to Reengrossed House Bill No. 83 by Representative Schlegel

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 7, after "policies;" delete the remainder of the line, and on page 1, delete line
3 8, and insert "short term loss of use"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 9, delete "require a civil" and on page 1, delete lines 10 through 13, and
6 insert the following:

7 "expressly allow for the payment of additional living expense coverage or fair rental
8 value coverage for a period of time not to exceed two weeks due in part to the
9 issuance of an order of evacuation and shall consider either of the following to be an
10 order of evacuation:"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 3

12 On page 1, line 17, after "policy and" delete "the" and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5,
13 and insert the following:

14 "a civil authority publicly declares that a mandatory evacuation order was
15 impracticable under the circumstances.

16 B. Any insurer issuing homeowner's insurance policies which do not
17 expressly allow for the payment of additional living expense coverage or fair rental
18 value coverage for a period of time not to exceed two weeks due in part to the
19 issuance of an order of evacuation shall offer an insured the opportunity to purchase
20 such coverage, subject to the requirements of Section A of this Section, for an
21 additional premium. The offer of this optional coverage shall only apply to
22 homeowner's policies written on or after January 1, 2023.

23 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023."
