- 9 issuance of an order of evacuation and shall consider either of the following to be an
- 10 order of evacuation:"

AMENDMENT NO. 3 11

- 12 On page 1, line 17, after "policy and" delete "the" and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 5,
- 13 and insert the following:
- 14 "a civil authority publicly declares that a mandatory evacuation order was
- 15 impracticable under the circumstances.
- B. Any insurer issuing homeowner's insurance policies which do not 16 expressly allow for the payment of additional living expense coverage or fair rental 17
- value coverage for a period of time not to exceed two weeks due in part to the 18 issuance of an order of evacuation shall offer an insured the opportunity to purchase 19
- 20 such coverage, subject to the requirements of Section A of this Section, for an
- additional premium. The offer of this optional coverage shall only apply to 21 22
- homeowner's policies written on or after January 1, 2023.
- 23 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023."
