Fields

Present law provides that each public postsecondary education management board has the authority to determine the fees paid by students. Proposed law requires payments to cover or a waiver of any mandatory fee imposed in accordance with present law except for tuition to be included in the compensation package of each graduate student serving as a teaching, research, or curatorial assistant. Requires each management board to adopt a policy for proposed law implementation.

Effective Aug. 1, 2024.

2. Remove proposed law relative to various fee exemptions for teaching and research assistants.
