Provides relative to the assessment of penalties for failure to timely file required reports

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the maximum penalty **from** <u>two</u> thousand dollars **to** <u>one thousand dollars</u> **when the penalty is sixty dollars per day**, for any candidate for district office and any treasurer or chairman of any political committee designated as a principal campaign committee or subsidiary committee of such a candidate.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes the maximum penalty **from** <u>one thousand dollars</u> **to** <u>five hundred dollars</u> **when the penalty is forty dollars per day**, for any candidate for all other offices and any treasurer or chairman of any political committee designated as a principal campaign committee or subsidiary committee of such a candidate.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may decrease SGF revenues because the maximum penalty imposed for failure to timely and accurately file certain reports to Ethics Administration would decrease from \$2,000 to \$1,000 for the \$60 per day penalty and for other office candidates the maximum penalty would decrease from \$1,000 to \$500 for the \$40 per day penalty.

NOTE: Penalties and fines imposed for the violation of these provisions are considered income not available to the Ethics Administration; thereby, accrue to the State General Fund. The 3 year average exceeds \$240,000 annually.

The three-year average of reports not filed or timely filed, the number of Campaign Finance reports not filed or not timely filed was approximately 890.
