Requests the chairman of the House Committee on Ways and Means and the chairman of the Senate Committee on Revenue and Fiscal Affairs to establish a joint subcommittee composed of three members of each respective committee to review laws with respect to La.'s exemptions, deductions, exclusions, credits, rebates, and other tax preference expenditures, identify the low-performing or antiquated tax preference expenditures, and make recommendations for the temporary or permanent reduction or elimination of such low-performing or antiquated tax preference expenditures, and to report its findings and recommendations prior to the 2023 R.S.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation is anticipated to result in an indeterminable, but minimal, increase in SGF expenditures associated with legislative per diems and travel reimbursements.

This resolution establishes a joint committee to study tax incentives and rebates. The committee consists of 6 legislators. If the committee meets outside of a legislative session, then the cost per meeting is anticipated to be \$1,008 (\$168 legislative per diem x 6 members) plus travel expenses.

The LFO, LLA, and staffs of the House of Representatives, Senate, and other agencies will likely absorb any additional duties with existing staff and resources.
