3 "(H) If Senate Bill No. 414 of the 2022 Regular Session becomes law,
4 Section 1 of that Act shall not become effective.

5 (I) If House Bill No. 1046 of the 2022 Regular Session becomes law, the 6 Louisiana State Law Institute is hereby authorized to incorporate the repeal of R.S. 7 36:610(D)(2) into the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 by removing R.S. 8 36:610(B)(3)(b) from the reenactments included in this Act and renumbering the 9 Subparagraphs within R.S. 36:610(B)(3) as reenacted by this Act in accordance with 10 such removals.

(J) If House Bill No. 933 of the 2022 Regular Session becomes law, the
Louisiana State Law Institute is hereby authorized to incorporate the repeal of R.S.
36:259(B)(28) into the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 by removing R.S.
36:259(G)(6) from the reenactments included in this Act."
