Establishes the Cybersecurity Redhibition Task Force.

The task force is comprised of:

- (1) The superintendent of La. State Police or his designee.
- (2) The director of the La. State Analytical Fusion Exchange or his designee.
- (3) The director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness or his designee.
- (4) The chief information officer, office of technology services, division of administration or his designee.
- (5) The La. attorney general or his designee.
- (6) The special agent in charge of the New Orleans field office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation or his designee.
- (7) The special agent in charge of the New Orleans field office of the United States Secret Service or his designee.
- (8) The officer in charge of the Baton Rouge office of the Dept. of Homeland Security or his designee.
- (9) The adjutant general of the La. Army National Guard or his designee.
- (10) The president of the Cyber Innovation Center in Bossier City, or another employee of the center as designated by the president.
- (11) The chairman of the Senate Select Committee on Homeland Security or a member of the committee designated by him.
- (12) The chairman of the House Select Committee on Homeland Security or a member of the committee designated by him.
