KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

PUBLIC DEFENDER. Requires the Louisiana Public Defender Board to annually enter into a contract with the University of Louisiana Monroe to provide certain statewide training. (7/1/22)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Require any contracts formed pursuant to proposed law to use existing funds appropriated by the legislature.

Present law provides for the powers, duties, and responsibilities of the Louisiana Public Defender Board, and provides that the board may enter into contracts with various attorneys, local, state, and federal agencies.

Proposed law retains present law and further provides that the Louisiana Public Defender Board shall enter into a contract with the University of Louisiana at Monroe, to provide training to certain attorneys, investigators, social workers, and staff. Requires any contracts formed with the University of Louisiana at Monroe to use existing funds appropriated by the legislature.

Effective July 1, 2022.
