SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Changes the proposed law enhanced minimum term of imprisonment from 8 years to 10 years.

Present law provides that the crime of carjacking is punishable by imprisonment at hard labor for between two and 20 years without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

Proposed law retains present law and provides for an increased penalty of not less than 10 nor more than 20 years, without the benefit of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence if serious bodily injury is caused during the commission of the crime of carjacking.

Effective Aug. 1, 2022.
