shall be transmitted by the governing authority of the parish to the criminal court fund of the Forty-Second Judicial District. As used in this Subsection, "special fund" means the special fund provided for in Subsection D of this Section, and "surplus monies" means the amount of money in the special fund in excess of fifty thousand dollars at the end of the calendar year. The surplus monies which are transferred by this Subsection may be used for any purpose for which the other monies in the criminal court fund of the Forty-Second Judicial District Court may be used.
