2	To amend and reenact R.S. 42:1119(B)(2)(a)(v), relative to nepotism; to provide relative to
3	family members of school board members and school district superintendents who
4	are employed by the school board; to provide relative to promotion of such
5	employees; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 42:1119(B)(2)(a)(v) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§1119. Nepotism

13	(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection:

16	(v) An immediate family member of a member of a local school board or of
17	a superintendent who is has been employed pursuant to Item (i) of this Subparagraph
18	for at least one year may be promoted to an administrative position by such school
19	board provided that such family member has the appropriate qualifications and
20	certifications for such position. A school board member whose immediate family
21	member is to be promoted to an administrative position pursuant to this Item shall
22	recuse himself from any action involving the promotion or assignment of job

HB NO. 411 **ENROLLED** 1 location of such employee, and a superintendent whose immediate family member 2 is to be promoted to an administrative position shall disqualify himself from any 3 action involving the promotion or assignment of job location of such employee. For 4 purposes of this Item, the term "certifications" shall not include any temporary or 5 provisional certification or certifications. 6 7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 9 by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 11 effective on the day following such approval.
