- 9 On page 2, delete lines 27 though 29 and insert the following:

10 "D. The failure to appear due to incarceration shall be a valid defense for any 11 violation of this Section, if the arrested person provides evidence of incarceration to the court pursuant to R.S. 15:714. The license shall be renewed and reissued without 12 13 payment, all failure to appear payments waived, and any other flags reported to the 14 Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall be resolved pursuant to statute. E. All notices from the Department of Public Safety and Corrections 15 described in Subsections A and B of this Section shall include the following 16 information: the summons information that the individual failed to appear on; the 17 date of the failure to appear; the contact information and name of the court where the 18 19 person needs to appear; and an explanation of the provisions of Code of Criminal 20 Procedure Art. 885.1 that a person's license shall not be suspended if they are 21 financially unable to pay any fines, fees, or costs related to the ticket and resolution of the pending suspension only requires the person's appearance with the court." 22
