2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" and before "enact" insert "amend and reenact Code of Criminal  
3 Procedure Article 973(E) and to"

5 On page 1, line 7, after "court;" and before "to" insert "to provide relative to the effects of  
6 expunged records of arrest and conviction;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 11, after "Section 1." and before "Code" insert "Code of Criminal Procedure  
9 Article 973(E) is hereby amended and reenacted and"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, between lines 12 and 13, insert the following:

12 Art. 973. Effect of expunged record of arrest or conviction

13 \* \* \*

14 E. Nothing in this Article shall be construed to limit or impair in any way the  
15 subsequent use of any expunged record of any arrests or convictions by a judge,  
16 magistrate, commissioner, law enforcement agency, criminal justice agency, or  
17 prosecutor including its use as a predicate offense, for the purposes of the Habitual  
18 Offender Law, setting bail, sentencing, or as otherwise authorized by law.

20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 2, at the end of line 28, insert the following:

22 "Nothing in this Paragraph shall be construed to require the arresting agency,  
23 booking agency, or the district attorney to manually segregate or sequester upon  
24 acknowledging or identifying such records."
