Amendments proposed by Representative Ivey to Engrossed House Bill No. 145 by Representative Edmonston

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "amend and reenact" delete the remainder of the line and delete line
3 3 and insert "R.S. 49:953.1(B)(2)(a) and 968(B)(introductory paragraph),
4 (D)(1)(b)(introductory paragraph) and (K)(1), to enact R.S. 49:950.1, and to repeal R.S.
5 49:968(B)(24)(b), relative to the Administrative Procedure Act; to"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, delete lines 5 and 6 and insert "provide for the submission of specified reports
8 regarding rules to legislators; to provide"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, line 9, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10
11 through 21 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 and insert the following:

12 "R.S. 49:953.1(B)(2)(a) and 968(B)(introductory paragraph), (D)(1)(b)(introductory
13 paragraph), and (K)(1) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 49:950.1 is hereby
14 enacted to read as follows:

15 "§950.1. Legislative electronic mail information

16 The chief clerical officers of the legislature shall maintain the
17 appropriate electronic mail addresses to be used to satisfy the requirements
18 of this Chapter that require transmittals to each member of the legislature and
19 to oversight committees via electronic mail."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 4

21 On page 3, between lines 14 and 15, insert the following:

22 "D.(1)

23 * * *

24 (b) The agency shall submit a report to the subcommittee and to each
25 member of the legislature, in the same manner as the submittal of the report
26 provided for in Subsection B of this Section, which shall include:

27 * * *

28 K.(1) Each year, no later than thirty days prior to the beginning of the
29 regular session of the legislature, each agency shall submit a report to the
30 appropriate committees and to each member of the legislature as provided for
31 in Subsection B of this Section. This report shall contain a statement of the
32 action taken by the agency with respect to adoption, amendment, or repeal
33 of each rule proposed for adoption, amendment, or repeal during the previous
34 year and a report of the action taken by the agency with respect to any
35 proposed fee adoption, increase, or decrease during the previous year.

1 Section 2. R.S. 49:968(B)(24)(b) is hereby repealed in its entirety."

2 AMENDMENT NO. 5

3 On page 3, line 15, change "Section 2." to "Section 3."
