# SENATE BILL NO. 366

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 22:976.1(B) and (D), relative to health insurance; to prohibit
3	certain health insurance cost-sharing practices; to provide for definitions; to provide
4	for fairness in enrollee cost-sharing practices; to provide for effectiveness; and to
5	provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 22:976.1(B) and (D) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as
8	follows:
9	§976.1. Fairness in enrollee cost sharing
10	* * *
11	B. Cost-sharing calculation. When calculating an enrollee's contribution to
12	any applicable cost-sharing requirement, a health insurance issuer shall include any
13	cost-sharing amounts paid by the enrollee or on behalf of the enrollee by another
14	person. If application of this requirement results in health savings account
15	ineligibility under 26 U.S.C. 223, this requirement shall apply for health savings
16	account-qualified high deductible health plans with respect to the deductible of
17	the plan after the enrollee has satisfied the minimum deductible under 26 U.S.C.
18	223, except with respect to items or services that are preventive care pursuant
19	to 26 U.S.C. 223(c)(2)(C), in which case the requirements of this Subsection shall
20	apply regardless of whether the minimum deductible under 26 U.S.C. 223 has
21	been satisfied.

23	D. The commissioner of insurance may promulgate rules and regulations in
24	accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act as are necessary to implement
25	this Section.

#### **ENROLLED**

1	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5	effective on the day following such approval.
