LAW ENFORCE/CRIM JUS COM: Provides relative to the composition of the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Changes the name of one of the members of the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice <u>from</u> the Louisiana chapter of the National Constables Association <u>to</u> the Louisiana City Marshals and City Constables Association.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for the composition of the La. Commission on Law Enforcement and Administration of Criminal Justice, and provides for 58 members of the commission.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the membership to 59 by adding the president of the La. Fraternal Order of Police as a member.

<u>Proposed law</u> further amends <u>present law</u> and changes the name of one of the members <u>from</u> the La. chapter of the National Constables Assoc. <u>to</u> the La. City Marshals and City Constables Assoc.
