Amendments proposed by Senator Peacock to Reengrossed House Bill No. 83 by Representative Schlegel

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 In Senate Committee Amendment No. 4 proposed by the Senate Committee on Insurance
3 and adopted by the Senate on May 12, 2022, on page 1, delete lines 12 through 26, and insert
4 the following:

5 "A. For losses that arise due to a catastrophic event in which a state of
6 disaster or emergency is declared by civil officials, for those areas within the
7 declaration, if a civil authority prohibits the insured from using their residential
8 premises as a result of damage to a neighboring premises due to a peril covered by
9 the policy, the civil authority prohibited use coverage shall be afforded as provided
10 in the policy.

11 B. For purposes of this Section, insurers shall interpret all actions of a civil
12 authority without regard to whether formal orders of evacuation were issued."
