HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

HB 477 2022 Regular Session Coussan

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS: Provides for new assistant district attorney positions for various judicial districts in the state

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical changes.
- 2. Changes effective date <u>from</u> August 1, 2022 <u>to</u> upon signature of the governor.
- 3. Adds eight additional assistant district attorneys subject to approval by the commission.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys that have already been approved by the Governor's Advisory and Review Commission on Assistant District Attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 1st JDC from 27 to 35.
- (2) 5th JDC <u>from</u> 6 <u>to</u> 7.
- (3) 7th JDC <u>from</u> 5 <u>to</u> 6.
- (4) 14th JDC <u>from</u> 23 <u>to</u> 24.
- (5) 15th JDC <u>from</u> 19 <u>to</u> 28.
- (6) 16th JDC <u>from</u> 21 <u>to</u> 23.
- (7) 18th JDC <u>from</u> 10 <u>to</u> 12.
- (8) 19th JDC <u>from</u> 48 <u>to</u> 54.
- (9) 21st JDC <u>from</u> 18 <u>to</u> 19.
- (10) 24th JDC <u>from</u> 52 <u>to</u> 54.
- (11) 29th JDC <u>from</u> 9 <u>to</u> 10.
- (12) 32nd JDC <u>from</u> 19 <u>to</u> 20.
- (13) 36th JDC <u>from</u> 4 <u>to</u> 5.
- (14) 37th JDC <u>from</u> 2 <u>to</u> 3.

Section 1 of <u>proposed law</u> shall become effective when an Act of the La. Legislature containing a specific appropriation of monies for the implementation of the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> becomes effective.

Sections 2 and 3 of <u>proposed law</u> shall become effective upon signature of the governor; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, <u>proposed law</u> becomes effective on the day following such approval by the legislature.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys, contingent upon the approval of the Governor's Advisory and Review Commission on Assistant District Attorneys, in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 12th JDC from 7 to 8.
- (2) 14th JDC <u>from</u> 23 <u>to</u> 25.
- (3) 18th JDC <u>from</u> 10 <u>to</u> 13.
- (4) 19th JDC <u>from</u> 48 <u>to</u> 55.
- (5) 26th JDC <u>from</u> 12 <u>to</u> 13.
- (6) 27th JDC from 11 to 12.
- (7) 32nd JDC <u>from</u> 19 <u>to</u> 21.
- (8) 34th JDC from 8 to 9.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that if any additional district attorney positions provided for in Section 2 of this Act are not approved by the Governor's Advisory and Review Commission on Assistant District Attorneys, such lack of approval shall not affect other additional positions provided for in Section 2 of this Act.

Proposed law provides that Section 2 of this Act is hereby declared severable.
