6 On page 3, delete lines 6 through 13 and insert the following:

"C.(1)(a) For all public records, except public records of state agencies, it shall be the duty of the custodian of such public records to provide copies to persons so requesting, unless the requestor fails to pay the applicable copying fees after being notified of the amount in advance of production or the requestor has an outstanding balance from a prior request. The custodian may establish and collect reasonable fees for making copies of public records. The custodian may request payment of fees in advance of production. Copies of records may be furnished without charge or at a reduced charge to indigent citizens of this state.

17 (2) For all public records of state agencies, it shall be the duty of the 18 custodian of such records to provide copies to persons so requesting, unless 19 the requestor fails to pay the applicable copying fees after being notified 20 of the amount in advance of production or the requestor has an 21 outstanding balance from a prior request. Fees for such copies shall be 22 charged according to the uniform fee schedule adopted by the commissioner 23 of administration, as provided by R.S. 39:241 or as otherwise fixed or 24 provided by law. Copies shall be provided at fees according to the schedule, 25 except for copies of public records the fees for the reproduction of which are otherwise fixed by law. Copies of records may be furnished without charge 26 27 or at a reduced charge to indigent citizens of this state or the persons whose 28 use of such copies, as determined by the custodian, will be limited to a public 29 purpose, including but not limited to use in a hearing before any 30 governmental regulatory commission."
