- On page 3, line 2, after the period "." delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 in its
- 14 entirety and insert the following:
- 15 "Except for good cause shown, the continued custody hearing shall be
- 16 <u>held within twenty-four hours and not later than seventy-two hours as provided</u>
- 17 in Article 819."
- 18 AMENDMENT NO. 6
- On page 5, delete lines 6 through 29 in their entirety and delete page 6 in its entirety and
- insert the following:
- "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor
- or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law
- without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the
- 24 Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by
- 25 the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval."
