<u>Proposed law</u> adds the Division of Administration, Office of Technology Services (OTS) is entitled to the criminal history record and identification files of the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information (the Bureau). <u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the Bureau to submit fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) for retention in the FBI rap back system. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Bureau shall make available to the OTS certain rap backs, provided however any recipient of information shall maintain the confidentiality of the criminal history information in accordance with applicable state or federal law.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. <u>Proposed law</u> adds the Division of Administration - Office of Technology Services to be able to request certain criminal history and identification files from the Louisiana Criminal Information and Identification within State Police.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> may result in an indeterminable increase in revenue to the Criminal Identification and Information Fund from the potential increase from applicants requesting fingerprint-based background checks. The state background check fee is \$26 and the federal background check fee is \$13.25 of which the Bureau us allowed to keep \$2 for maintenance of the connection to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
