RACING/HORSE: Provides relative to licenses issued by the Louisiana State Racing Commission

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Changes the effective date <u>from</u> effective upon signature of the governor <u>to</u> June 30, 2022.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the La. State Racing Commission (commission) to issue licenses in accordance with <u>present law</u> and applicable rules and regulations adopted by the commission. Authorizes the commission to revoke a license to cause the license holder to become ineligible to participate in racing.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides for a license issued by the commission to remain active for a period of not more than 1 year.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the license period <u>from</u> not more than 1 year <u>to</u> not more than 3 years.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes owners, trainers, jockeys, jockey agents, exercise persons, and veterinarians to renew the annual license fee for up to a 3-year period which expires on June 30th of the third year. <u>Present law</u> applies to the registration of colors.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains and extends <u>present law</u> to the renewals of annual license fees for partnership licenses.

Effective June 30, 2022.
