2	To enact R.S. 6:1085.1, relative to residential mortgage lenders; to provide for authority of
3	the commissioner of the office of financial institutions; to provide for failure of a
4	originator or broker to adhere to reasonable standards; to provide for continuing
5	education in certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 6:1085.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
8	§1085.1. Authority of the commissioner to impose continuing education
9	In addition to any other authority conferred upon the commissioner by this
10	Chapter, the commissioner may impose a requirement of additional continuing
11	education classes, not to exceed eight hours, on any residential mortgage originator
12	or broker based on a finding by the commissioner that such originator or broker
13	failed to adhere to reasonable standards of professional conduct while engaging in
	a residential mortgage lending activity that negatively impacted a consumer.
