12 "§1176. Grounds for rejection of application

13 * * *

14 B. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, all decisions
15 relative to the granting of leave pursuant to this Section shall be made by the
16 superintendent of the local public school system. If the superintendent denies an
17 application for sabbatical leave, the applicant may appeal the decision to the school
18 board. Any such appeal shall be made in writing to the president of the school board
19 within fifteen work-days after receipt of the denial. At the next scheduled school
20 board meeting following the receipt of the appeal, the school board shall consider
21 whether to conduct a full hearing relative to the appeal. The board shall notify the
22 applicant and the superintendent of its decision within five work-days and, if the
23 appeal will be heard, a date for the hearing. If the school board hears the appeal, it
24 shall maintain a transcript of the proceedings, make a written recommendation for
25 disposition of the appeal, and provide a copy of the decision and the transcript to the
26 applicant and superintendent within five work-days.

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
