- 9 (ii) Human trafficking offenses as defined in R.S. 14:46.2 and 46.3.
- 10 (iii) Offenses affecting the health and morals of minors, R.S. 14:91 et seq.
- (iv) Offenses affecting the health and safety of person with infirmities,
- 12 R.S.14:93.3 et seq.
- 13 (v) Video voyeurism.
- 14 (vi) Cruelty to animals.
- 15 <u>(vii) Dogfighting.</u>
- (f) The booking photograph is part of a law enforcement file solely because
- the subject of the booking photograph was filler as defined by Article 252.
- 18 (g) Any entity, person, or agency that publishes a booking photograph 19 according to this Paragraph shall include a disclaimer that states "all persons are
- 20 presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.""

- 23 "(3) No law enforcement agency or employee thereof shall be subject to civil
- 24 <u>action or be held liable when the publication, release, or dissemination was made by</u>
- 25 mistake of fact or error, or was inadvertent and made in good faith."
