KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

ELECTED OFFICIALS. Prohibits a public officer who has retired or resigned from office from qualifying for the same office at a special election to fill the position. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Changes persons subject to <u>proposed law from public officers to elected officials.</u>
- 2. Removes <u>proposed law</u> providing that a person who retired or resigned from a Lawrason Act municipal governing authority could not be a candidate for any vacant position on the governing authority being filled prior to the next regular election.
- 3. Changes effective date.
