VACCINES/VACCINATION

Subject: Vaccinations in Schools

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Prohibits the administration of vaccines to minors on school property and at school-sponsored events unless certain conditions are met

Proposed law provides that prior to the administration of vaccines to minors on an educational institution or facility's property and at institution or facility-sponsored events, the institution or facility's governing authority may require that a registered nurse or licensed medical physician is present and parental permission is obtained through a dual authentication process including both a parental signature and oral confirmation by a parent, either in-person or over the telephone. Provides that such permission may be granted either by the parent or legal guardian, as applicable. Provides that the governing authority of an education institution or facility may adopt rules to prohibit the institution or facility from participating in or sponsoring any event related to the administration of vaccines.
