2	To amend and reenact R.S. 37:1271(A) and the introductory paragraph of 1285(A) and to
3	enact Part I-D of Chapter 15 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950,
4	to be comprised of R.S. 37:1310.11 and 1310.12, relative to bridge year graduate
5	physicians; to provide for the certification of bridge year graduate physicians; to
6	provide for the powers and duties of the Louisiana State Board of Medical
7	Examiners; to provide for compensation for services by bridge year graduate
8	physicians; and to provide for related matters.
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 37:1271(A) and the introductory paragraph of 1285(A) are hereby
11	amended and reenacted and Part I-D of Chapter 15 of Title 37 of the Louisiana Revised
12	Statutes of 1950, comprised of R.S. 37:1310.11 and 1310.12, is hereby enacted to read as
13	follows:
14	§1271. License to practice medicine or telemedicine required
15	A. No person shall practice medicine as defined herein in this Part until he
16	possesses a duly recorded license issued under pursuant to this Part, or a permit or
17	registration as provided for herein in this Part, or a certificate issued pursuant to
18	Part I-D of this Chapter.

20	§1285. Causes for nonissuance; suspension; revocation; or the imposition of
21	restrictions; fines; reinstatement; publication of action; stays
22	A. The board may refuse to issue, or may suspend or revoke any license or
23	permit, or impose probationary or other restrictions on any license, or permit, or
24	certificate issued pursuant to this Part or Part I-D of this Chapter for the following
25	causes:

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1	PART I-D. BRIDGE YEAR GRADUATE PHYSICIANS
2	§1310.11. Bridge year graduate physicians
3	A. The Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, referred to
4	hereafter in this Section as the "board", may develop, implement, and maintain
5	a program that allows an individual who meets certain criteria as set forth by
6	the board to be certified by the board to practice medicine as a bridge year
7	graduate physician. Such certification shall be valid for one year and may be
8	renewed for no more than two additional one-year periods upon application to
9	the board.
10	B. The board shall provide for the criteria for participation in the bridge
11	year graduate physician program which, at a minimum, shall require the
12	individual seeking certification to meet the following qualifications:
13	(1) He is a graduate of an accredited medical school.
14	(2) He applied to, but was not accepted into, an accredited medical
15	residency training program for the first year following medical school
16	graduation.
17	C. The board shall determine criteria for selection of applicants should
18	the number of applicants exceed the available capacity of the program.
19	D. The board shall provide for the prescriptive authority of a bridge
20	year graduate physician including prescribing legend and certain controlled
21	drugs.
22	E. The board may suspend, terminate, or revoke a bridge year graduate
23	physician certificate prior to the expiration of one year for any reason provided
24	by law or board rule for the termination of licenses, permits, registrations, or
25	certificates issued by the board, including but not limited to a violation of any
26	provision of this Part or the rules promulgated by the board pursuant to this
27	Part.
28	F. An individual holding a certification to practice as a bridge year
29	graduate physician shall practice only under the direct supervision of a

board-certified physician holding a license in good standing with the board.

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G. The services provided by an individual holding a certificate to 1 2 practice as a bridge year graduate physician shall be compensable in 3 accordance with customary medical billing practices. H. A certificate issued in accordance with the provisions of this Part 4 5 shall not confer any future right to full, unrestricted licensure. §1310.12. Rulemaking 6 7 The Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners shall adopt rules and regulations for the administration of this Part as are necessary for the adequate 8 protection of the health and welfare of the citizens of this state. 9 10 Section 2.
