1	§417. Qualified truck stop criteria; amenities
2	A. As used in this Chapter, a qualified truck stop facility shall mean a facility
3	covering at least five developed contiguous acres which sells fuel, lubricating oil,
4	and other vehicular merchandise, such as batteries, tires, or vehicle parts for
5	eighteen-wheel tractor-trailers, and which also meets all of the following criteria:
6	* * *
7	(6) It must have at least four of the following amenities, except for reason
8	of force majeure affecting the ability to maintain the amenities for a reasonable
9	period of time, as determined by the division following the interruption of such
10	ability:

12	(h) A Class-A General retail permit operating as a sports wagering lounge
13	which sells food or has an onsite restaurant.

15	Section 2. R.S. 27:417(A)(2) is hereby repealed in its entirety.
