POSTSECONDARY ED. Provides that certain graduate students shall be exempt from mandatory student fees. (8/1/24)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Adds requirement that payment for, or waivers of, mandatory fees (other than tuition) be included in compensation packages for teaching, research, and curatorial assistants.
- 2. Removes <u>proposed law</u> relative to various fee exemptions for teaching and research assistants.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Fields

<u>Present law</u> provides that each public postsecondary education management board has the authority to determine the fees paid by students.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires payments to cover or provide a waiver of any mandatory fee imposed in accordance with <u>present law</u> except for tuition to be included in the compensation package of each graduate student serving as a teaching, research, or curatorial assistant. Requires each management board to adopt a policy for <u>proposed law</u> implementation.
