EN SEE FISC NOTE LF EX See Note Requires public school governing authorities and public schools to post on their websites laws pertaining to parental access to instructional materials and the Parents' Bill of Rights

Proposed legislation requires each school governing authority to post prominently on its website information explaining the rights that parents have relative to accessing the instructional materials used in the education of their child and other rights pertaining to their child's education, and to distribute this information to parents annually during the first week of school. The information shall include an easily understandable summary and the full text and legal citation of R.S. 17:355, which provides relative to parental access to instructional materials, and R.S. 17:406.9, which provides for the Parents' Bill of Rights for Public Schools. Proposed legislation provides that the proposed legislation as well as R.S. 17:355 also apply to charter schools.
