Requires the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness to adopt certain rules. (8/1/22)

Proposed law provides for the Louisiana Commission on School and Nonprofit Security comprised of the following members, the director of Governor's Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP) or his designee, the chair of the House Select Committee on Homeland Security (SCHS) or his designee, chair of Senate SCHS or his designee, superintendent of state police or his designee, and the executive director of the Louisiana Interchurch Conference or his designee. Proposed law provides that the commission shall elect a chairman by a vote of a majority of the members. Proposed law provides that prior to August 1, 2022 that GOHSEP shall promulgate standards and regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act regarding disbursement of assets and diversion of resources during a federally or gubernatorially declared emergency. Proposed law provides that GOHSEP shall utilize emergency rulemaking for the promulgation of the initial administrative rules for the expeditious implementation of the provisions of the proposed law. Proposed law amends present law by changing the Commission **from** the "Louisiana Commission on Nonprofit Safety and Security" **to** "Louisiana Commission on School and Nonprofit Security". Proposed law adds to present law that the appointment to the Commission for the Louisiana Sheriff's Association or his designee be a person with expertise in terrorist attacks.
