3 WHEREAS, Mayor Clarence Fields is a lifelong resident of Pineville, Louisiana, and
4 he was a longtime employee of the Central Louisiana Electric Company (Cleco) before
5 working in local government as a city councilman; and

6 WHEREAS, in 1999, Clarence Fields was appointed as mayor of Pineville; and

7 WHEREAS, Mayor Fields served a total of six terms as mayor and ran unopposed
8 in his last four elections; and

9 WHEREAS, Clarence Fields' accomplishments as mayor are extensive and include
10 multimillion dollar projects that rejuvenated Pineville's business, recreation, and
11 infrastructure; new residential and commercial developments; and the city of Pineville has
12 won numerous "cleanest city" awards from the Louisiana Garden Club Foundation; and

13 WHEREAS, Mayor Fields currently serves on numerous community and statewide
14 boards including the Rapides Area Planning Commission, the Metropolitan Planning
15 Organization, and the Rapides Council on Aging; and

17 the Louisiana Municipal Association and he currently serves on the executive board and he
