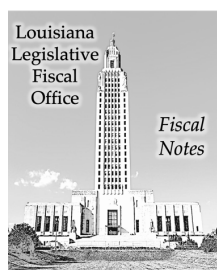

Subject: School Enrollment Reporting Requirements		

SCHOOLS EN NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1
Requires the state Department of Education to provide student attendance data of certain students to local school governing authorities. (gov sig)

Proposed legislation requires the Louisiana Department of Education (LDE) to report, for each child enrolled in an approved home study program, the student's legal name, date of birth, and physical address to the school system in which the child was most recently enrolled, and if different, the school system in which the child resides, within 30 days of approval or denial of an application for a home study program, and within 30 days of the failure to receive an annual renewal application for a previously approved home study program. Proposed legislation provides that the LDE shall not record such children as dropouts attributable to the public school in which the child was most recently enrolled or the public school in which the child would otherwise attend. Provides that no school system shall be responsible for collecting and maintaining school attendance data for any child who is enrolled in an approved home study program unless and until the parent subsequently enrolls the child in a public school in the public school system. Effective upon governor's signature.
